RAMP UP

RAMP UP (Retail, Administrative & Mission People United Partnership) strengthens collaboration across Goodwill teams and connects employees to local community events and partnerships throughout Nebraska.

Community Spend Program

Through Community Spend, Goodwill leaders support qualified nonprofit organizations in their communities, helping fund programs that align with Goodwill's mission and local needs.

Volunteer Day Program

Eligible employees are encouraged to give back through hands-on service, strengthening partnerships and fostering civic engagement.

Assistance Certificates

Goodwill provides assistance certificates to help individuals and families access essential clothing and household goods during times of need.

Margaret Mullen Fund

Established in 1993, this fund provides emergency financial assistance to individuals receiving Goodwill services, helping stabilize housing, health, and employment.

Maggie Thompson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship supports high school students with disabilities who are pursuing education or employment, honoring a legacy of independence and achievement.
